Anna Ehlmann ²⁷


Congratulations to freshman Anna Ehlmann our Student of the Month!

Forming responsible young men on and off the field

Father/Son Letter Reading event in its second year



On October 12, seven senior football players stood in front of Duchesne's chapel while their fathers and other important role models read to them letters expressing their pride in the boys' development as a team and as young men.

This Father/Son Letter Reading program was initiated by Vince Morris, Duchesne head football coach, last year as a way to continue his coaching methodology of teaching his students how to act on the field, and in every day life as they begin to take on adulthood.

Morris picked up on the program from Chad Masters, a head coach he worked with at Father Tolton and St. John Vianney high schools.

"It shows young men the emotional vulnerability it takes to be a man and how to deal with strong emotions," said Morris.

The night offered the senior players and their fathers a chance to connect in a way they may not otherwise have the opportunity to do.

"I really believe this event helps father figures take a step back from the day to day interactions with our sons, and convey all the great things they do that maybe we don't say as often as we should," said Travis Kundel, father of Ryan

Kundel. "In my particular case, I recognized the great things he's done, associated with football and outside of football, and challenge him going forward."

Morris says the event also stresses the importance that father figures play in the students' everyday life.

On October 6, the DHS Diamondline dance team led over 100 excited grade-school dancers to the field to perform a Taylor Swift dance routine at halftime during the boys varsity soccer game.

The event, called Friday Night Lights (Taylor's Version), was planned by Diamondline head coach Borgmeyer Anita and Diamondline parent and DHS board member Dana Buckner to share the excitement of Duchesne's halftime performances with local grade school students and raise money for uniforms, jackets, poms, and other items for the dance team.

"Diamondline has always had summer dance camps," said Borgmeyer. "We wanted to bring [the kids] to the fun of our DHS Friday Night Lights!"
