Dear Parents,

We are sending you this information to enable you to meet application deadlines. Parents applying for financial aid will be required to apply to the website, <u>www.ttef-stl.org</u>, for the *Beyond Sunday* Fellows Program, Catholic Family Tuition Assistance, and the Parish Employees Endowment Fund. *You must apply for these scholarships between January 28 and February 28, 2019.*

Please also keep in mind that parents will still be required to apply to FACTS for local scholarships, tuition assistance, and work study offered by Duchesne High School. It is very important that parents understand the need to apply in both places. If parents requesting financial aid do not apply for the new *Beyond Sunday* Fellows scholarship, Duchesne will not be able to solely support the financial needs from our local resources.

Enclosed you will find information on how to apply for the new *Beyond Sunday* Fellows scholarship, CFTA (Catholic Family Tuition Assistance), and PEEF (Parish Employees Endowment Fund); as well as information on how to apply for Duchesne scholarships, tuition assistance, and work study.

Scholarship Information for Parents for the 2019-2020 School Year

One application is used to apply for all scholarships funded by the Catholic Education Office, the Roman Catholic Foundation of Eastern Missouri, and the Today & Tomorrow Educational Foundation. To apply, please visit <u>www.ttef-stl.org</u> and click Apply Here. The Scholarship Office at TTEF will review your family's application and determine if your family is eligible for any awards offered based on each program's guidelines and funding availability. The application is online only and is free of cost!

For families applying to Archdiocesan/parochial elementary schools: Funding is available through Alive! In Christ for approximately 200 *new* awards for students of all faiths. Alive! In Christ is first-come, first-served and the maximum award is \$2,000. Residents of the City of St. Louis applying for Archdiocesan and private schools in the City may be eligible to receive Help for Today, Hope for Tomorrow. Maximum award in this program is also \$2,000 and approximately 350 new awards will be available.

Approximately 140 *new* awards will also be available through the Beyond Sunday scholarship program for Catholic families registered in a parish. The maximum award for new recipients in this program is \$1,750 and the application deadline is February 28th, 2019. Because demand is high and preference for Beyond Sunday scholarships is given to Catholic families registered in a parish, it is expected that all new awardees will be registered Catholics.

For families applying to Archdiocesan and private-Catholic high schools: Approximately 50 *new* Beyond Sunday Fellows scholarships will be available, primarily for incoming freshmen applying for Archdiocesan high schools. Due to high demand, it is expected that all new awardees will be registered Catholics. The maximum award for new recipients in this program is \$3,500 and the deadline to apply is February 28th, 2019.

For families currently receiving *ANY* **scholarship:** All families are encouraged to apply as early as possible. New *and* returning applications for Beyond Sunday, SOAR!, CFTA, and PEEF are due by February 28th, 2019. Alive! In Christ is first-come, first-served, including for all eligible siblings! City residents should also apply as early as possible to be considered for new awards in Help for Today, Hope for Tomorrow. Requalification applications for Alive! In Christ and Help for Today, Hope for Tomorrow may be submitted through May 1st, 2019. However, you MUST apply by February 28th to be considered for any other programs.

<u>Catholic Families</u> applying to Archdiocesan/parochial elementary and high schools may be able to receive funding *in addition* to Alive! In Christ, Help for Today, Hope for Tomorrow, or Beyond Sunday, through Catholic Families Tuition Assistance. Application deadline is February 28th, 2019.

<u>Students of parish employees</u> working 1,000 hours or more per year may receive funding *in addition* to Alive! In Christ, Help for Today, Hope for Tomorrow, or Beyond Sunday through the Parish Employees Endowment Fund. Application deadline is February 28th, 2019.

Families currently receiving a Beyond Sunday scholarship are not affected by the adjusted 18-19 award amounts. Requalifying awards are not subject to award amounts in Beyond Sunday unless an award would increase.

Important Additional Information

- Individual students may not receive more than one scholarship if awarded, not including Catholic Families Tuition Assistance and Parish Employees Endowment Fund. These funds may be awarded in addition to the other scholarships listed. Families may have multiple children receiving scholarships, depending on program guidelines.
- Documents needed to complete applications include:
 - High School Students are required to submit responses to two short answer questions and contact information for two references at the time of application to be considered for the Beyond Sunday Fellows Program. Frequently Asked Questions

How many scholarships will be available for the 2019-2020 school year?

Up to 50 new Beyond Sunday Fellows scholarships will be awarded throughout the Archdiocese of St. Louis, primarily for incoming freshmen.

Who should apply?

More than 1,400 high school applications were received last year for a total of 35 new awards. While the Beyond Sunday Fellows Program is open to all faiths, Catholic students in Catholic families who are registered in a parish receive priority, and 100% of the program's current recipients meet this criteria. The Roman Catholic Foundation anticipates this will be the same in the coming years.

How are award decisions made for the Beyond Sunday Fellows?

Award decisions are made according to the following priorities:

- Family's Income Eligibility
 - Required supporting documentation of income listed on application must be submitted by applicant and verified by the TTEF scholarship office by February 28, 2019.
 - To be considered income-eligible, a family's income must fall within the Beyond Sunday income guidelines before any changes to income.
- Number of Awards per Grade Level
 - An approximately equal number of awards per grade level will be maintained from year to year
 - Number of Awards per School
 - A minimum of one award per school, either new or requalifying, will typically be maintained for each school with qualified applications
- Student short answer responses that demonstrate alignment with the objectives of the Fellows program
 - While there is a length requirement, responses are evaluated on content, not mechanics or writing ability
 - Please note: Responses must be entered directly into the space available on the online application. Due to high volume, emailed, faxed, and mailed short answer responses and edits <u>will not be considered</u>. We are also unable to accept emailed, faxed, or mailed contact information for references and cannot accept any letters of recommendation.

When are award decisions made?

Award decisions are made immediately after the Beyond Sunday application deadline (February 28, 2019). Due to the high volume of applications received, late applications cannot be accepted. Applications without short answer responses, essays, or verified income by the deadline will not be considered.

Why are there new income guidelines?

The objective of the Beyond Sunday Scholarship program is increase access to high-quality Catholic education for middle-income families. The Beyond Sunday income guidelines have been revised to align with the US Census' definition of middle-income.



If you are a resident of St. Louis City and are applying for one or more children to attend an elementary school in St. Louis City, you will be required to upload one proof of residency. A valid proof of residency can be a copy of a utility bill showing your name (or your spouse's entered on application) and your street address in the City; a copy of your/your spouse's Missouri Driver's License; or your/your spouse's Missouri Voter Registration Card.



Applications must be completed by the student and may be typed or handwritten. The essay must be typed. Students choosing to handwrite applications must use blue or black ink. All applications are confidential and will be reviewed by the appropriate evaluation committee.

Alumni Association Scholarship - \$500 awarded annually to one incoming freshman who is the child or grandchild of a St. Peter / Duchesne High School alum and selects Duchesne as their first choice school. The award is renewable for subsequent years by resubmitting an application and maintaining a 3.0 grade point average. (*Grade 9*)

Anita Venvertioh Memorial Art Scholarship - \$500 will be awarded to a student interested in art education at Duchesne. Along with this application students must submit 3 to 5 samples of their best artwork; samples demonstrating proficiency in various media are preferred. This is a non-renewable award for 9th grade only. *(Grade 9)*

Dr. Clever Scholarship - \$1,000 is awarded annually to a senior with a 3.0 GPA or better, completion of the on-line FACTS Financial Aid Assessment and this application form. (*Grade 12*)

Frank Kister Family Foundation - \$2,000 (\$500 for each of four years at DHS) is awarded to an incoming freshman who best exemplifies the spirit of Frank Kister with regard to community service and awareness of the needs and interests of others. The award is broken into payments of \$500 for each year the student is enrolled at Duchesne. (*Grade 9*)

Jan Schultehenrich Scholarship - \$750 is awarded to an incoming freshman who demonstrates good work habits and school citizenship, among those students applying for financial aid. To be considered, the student's family must file the on-line FACTS financial aid application. The award is not automatically renewable; an application must be submitted each year. (*Grade 9*)

Ron Kjar Service & Scholarship Award – \$500 is awarded to several seniors with a 3.5 or better cumulative GPA who demonstrate a balance of community service and academic excellence. The application must be accompanied by two recommendations from faculty members attesting to those two attributes. Finalists may be required to participate in an interview as part of the selection process. (*Grade 12*)

Timothy O. Hill Memorial Scholarship - \$500 is awarded to an incoming freshman based on school achievements, co-curricular activities and service to the community. This is a non-renewable award for 9th grade only. (*Grade 9*)

Victoria Reid Scholarship - \$1,000 awarded annually to one student who demonstrates financial need and is of Hispanic heritage (50% or more – at least one parent must have origins in a Spanish-speaking country). Applicants must complete the application, essay and will be interviewed by the scholarship committee. The award is not automatically renewable; an application must be submitted each year. (*Grades 9-12*)

Please note: All students are automatically considered for the following scholarships, no application is required:

President's Scholarship - \$800 is automatically awarded to any incoming freshman who selects Duchesne as their first choice school, attends a Catholic grade school, has a minimum 4.0 GPA, scores 90% or better on cumulative ITBS in 8th grade and has acceptable conduct. This award renews annually based on maintaining a 4.0 GPA and acceptable conduct. (Grade 9)

Dean's Scholarship - \$500 is automatically awarded to any incoming freshman who selects Duchesne as their first choice school, has a B or better in core 8th grade classes, scores 80% or better on cumulative ITBS in 8th grade and has acceptable conduct. Students do no need to attend a Catholic grade school. This award renews annually based on maintaining a 3.60 GPA and acceptable conduct. (Grade 9)

All students who complete the FACTS Financial Needs Assessment are automatically considered for the following Scholarships, no application is required:

Duchesne Direct Tuition Assistance – Award amount varies. Awarded to all students based solely on financial need. Students must re-apply each year via the FACTS Financial Needs Assessment. *A significant portion of our need based financial aid is dedicated to our work study program.* **Work Study Applicants must complete the attached application to be** *considered for that award.*

Mary Lou Hannegan Scholarship – Award amount varies. This is awarded to an incoming 9th grade student who has the highest ITBS scores and demonstrated financial need as determined by the FACTS process. This is a non-renewable grant. (Grade 9)

Scheidegger Challenge Fund for Tuition Aid - Award amount varies. This is awarded to students in all grades that demonstrate significant financial need. (Grades 9 – 12)

Some awards may not be available each year as they are subject to endowment results and income.

DUCHESNE HIGH SCHOOL Summer 2019 Work Program Application



Work study is available during the summer months for interested students. Each student will be able to work off part of his/her tuition bill by working approximately 4 days per week (Monday-Thursday) from 7:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. (with ½ hour lunch and other

breaks). The pay is applied directly to the tuition, without deductions. The rate is \$8.75 per hour. The program is open to a limited number of students. Awards are made based on financial need and will be prioritized on a first-come, first-serve basis.

The tentative summer work schedule is from Monday, June 3 through Thursday, June 27, 2019 and Monday, July 1 through Thursday, July 25, 2019, excluding 4th of July. Students may be awarded a 4-week or 8-week plan. Students working the full time could be credited with \$2,000 towards their tuition.

In order to determine the students in need of this opportunity, we are asking that each family requesting summer work fill out this form and the FACTS application indicating financial need. This form may be obtained from school office or go to DHS website.

Guidelines for admittance to the summer work program include:

- 1) The Summer Work Application must be completed and sent to the DHS Business Office
- 2) The family must be in need of financial assistance and fill out the FACTS application on-line
- 3) The student must fulfill the time requirements and performance standards to remain in the program
- 4) The student must show diligence in work, willingness to concentrate on the task assigned, and acceptance of a variety of jobs
- 5) The student must be able to work without constant supervision

Students will be assigned various indoor and outdoor work assignments. Students are expected to work the entire time. Any student found not working or misbehaving will be given a warning. The second warning will mean automatic dismissal from the Summer Work Program.

Each student must obey any staff member of DHS; teachers, maintenance personnel, administrative assistants, and administration. Mr. Dominic Muich, Facilities Manager or the Program Supervisor, must be notified of any tardiness, absence, or early departure in advance. For any of these conditions to occur, parental explanation is necessary.
