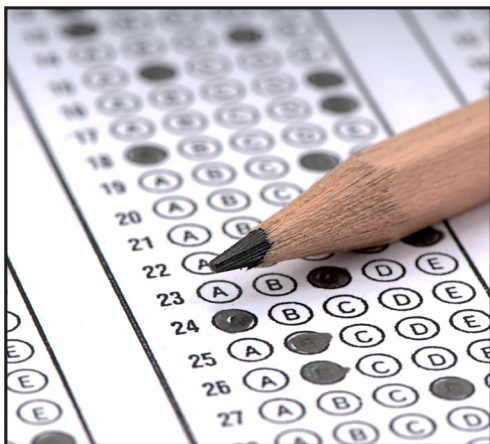
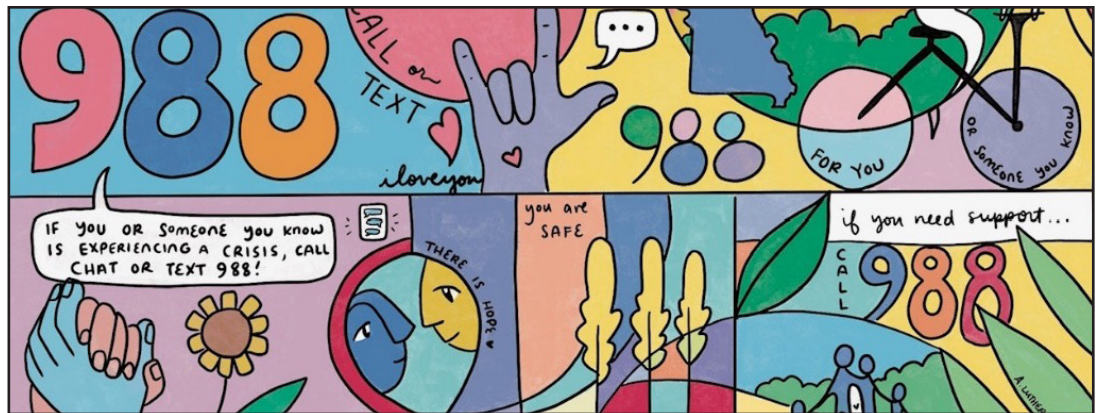

On Tuesday, April 9 all juniors will take an ACT exam, the results of which may serve for college admission and scholarship eligibility purposes. Sophomores and freshmen will take the Pre-Act and the Pre-ACT 9 respectively. Testing will begin with the normal school

starting time of 7:45 a.m. and conclude, with students dismissed from school, at approximately 11:30 a.m. Seniors are dismissed from classes on Testing Day. All registration procedures will be completed at school. There is no cost for parents.

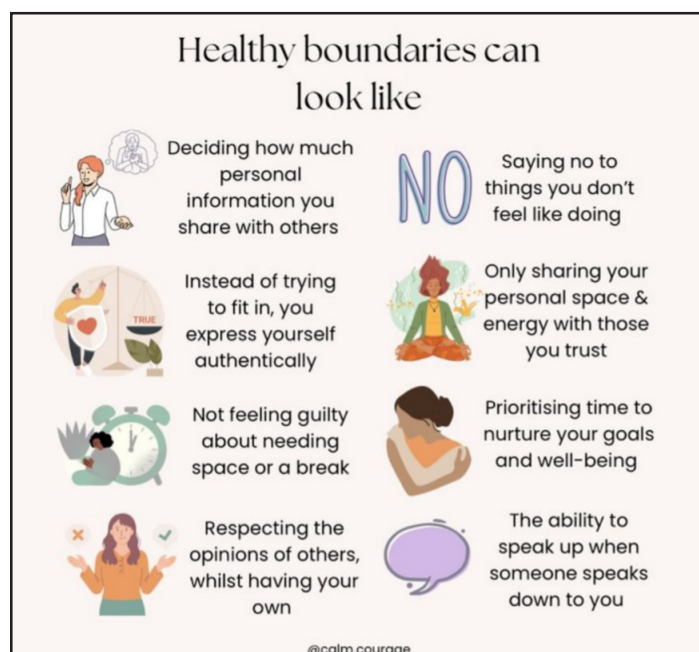
