SENIOR PARENTS!

Enter your students' college scholarships on the DHS website (Quick Links at top, then "Parents", then "Class of 2023 College Acceptance"). Enter offered scholarships for each college separately. This important information is needed for the graduation program and must be submitted by April 17.

Parents of senior athletes intending to participate in NCAA or NAIA sports should request their transcripts via Naviance using the same process used to request college admission transcripts. Senior athletes should see Mr. Tinsley if they have questions.

A+ SCHOLARSHIP

Senior students pursuing the A+ Scholarship must submit their re-

quired tutoring/mentoring hours to Mobilserve by May 1.

COLLEGE CREDIT COURSES

Instructions for transferring college credit earned through UMSL (ACC) or SLU (1818) will be distributed at graduation practice or by accessing "transcript requests" through those colleges.

REMINDER!

Testing Day, March 28! Juniors will take the ACT, and sophomores and freshmen will take a version of the PreACT. Testing will begin at 7:45 and students will be dismissed at approximately 11:30. Seniors are excused from classes.
