

*Lesson 1: Every Journey is Born from a Dream*

*Instructions for Philippine Launches Her Dream—A Journal Activity*

*And Putting All the Pieces Together to Build Your Own Dream*

Materials needed per student: personal journal (single subject spiral notebook or pronged folder with loose leaf paper); copy of ***“Philippine’s Steps to Launching her Life Dream...Inspiration for Yours!”***

Puzzling together Philippine’s dream through journaling:

- a. Use the watermarked image of Philippine divided into 6 sections. These will be the puzzle pieces for the journal activity, ***“Philippine’s Steps to Launching her Life Dream...Inspiration for Yours!”***
- b. Adhere image to the front page of a personal journal that can be used throughout the unit. Option: Make 2 copies of the watermarked image. Paste the first copy on the front of the journal. Cut the second copy into six sections and glue onto the appropriate journal page.
- c. For each puzzle block, have the students investigate that particular step of Philippine’s story and quest for her dream. Discuss the questions relating Philippine’s struggle to your student’s future goals. This could take place in a partner, small group or whole class format. Students can use additional journal pages to reflect on the discussion and creatively respond to the personal questions.
- d. Reminder: Reflection opportunities will be posed with each segment of Philippine’s journey to the New World. Have students keep their journals readily available for the remainder of the bicentennial journey.
