## Lesson 2: Prepping, Packing & Panhandling

## Instructions for Philippine's Companions for the Journey Crossing the Atlantic Ocean on the Rebecca

- 1. Generate ideas from students about being part of a "team" and what that means to them. Brainstorm quick examples of teams and teamwork.
- 2. Give students a copy of the article, *Companions of Philippine Duchesne on the Rebecca* (see Student Documents and Activities column).
- 3. What do they notice just looking at the article? Each of Philippine's companions are only given a paragraph description. There is much left to speculation about these women, except that they agreed to join the journey with little to no hesitation.
- 4. **Reading purpose**: Evaluate each of the companions and how they impacted Philippine's mission.
- 5. **Annotate**: For each paragraph describing one of Philippine's companions, have students circle important data and jot down questions or inferences in the margin.
- 6. Share annotations in small groups, encouraging students to add onto their own notes based on insights gained from classmates.
- 7. Continue working in small groups to discuss and then answer remaining queries about why working as a team and having companions through the trials and journeys of life is essential.
