2026-2027 SCHOLARSHIP & FINANCIAL AID OPPORTUNITIES AND APPLICATIONS

For 2026-2027 Freshmen — automatic scholarships

Students are automatically considered for the President's, Principals, and Dean's scholarships. No application is required. These awards are renewed annually if the student has acceptable conduct and maintains the stated GPA.

President's Scholarship — \$2,000 to students who select Duchesne as their first-choice school, attend a Catholic grade school, have a min. 4.0 GPA, and score 95% or better on the Complete Composite ITBS, NWEA MAP, or comparable testing in 8th grade. (Maintain 4.0 GPA at DHS for auto renewal.)

Principal's Scholarship — \$1,000 to students who select Duchesne as their first-choice school, attend a Catholic grade school, have a min. 4.0 GPA, and score 90-94% on the Complete Composite ITBS, NWEA MAP, or comparable testing in 8th grade. (Maintain 4.0 GPA at DHS for auto renewal.)

Dean's Scholarship — \$750 to students who select Duchesne as their first-choice school, have B or better in core 8th-grade classes, and score 80-89% or better on the Complete Composite ITBS, NWEA MAP, or comparable testing in 8th grade. Catholic grade school attendance is not required. (Maintain 3.6 GPA at DHS for auto renewal.)

For 2026-2027 All Grade Levels — automatic scholarship

Nathan Spiess First Responder/Military Scholarship — \$1,500 to students with a parent who is a First Responder (police, fire, EMT/ambulance) or is in the Military (active or reserve). Please confirm employment by emailing nkohl@duchesne-hs.org.

Special Scholarships (Duchesne Scholarship Application and BBFA not required)

Dolores Boschert Memorial Duchesne Scholarship — All Grade Levels, Financial Need

\$2,000 scholarship awarded in Dolores' memory annually to one student of any grade level according to the following criteria:

-Cumulative GPA of at least 3.0

-Statement of financial need

-A video submission **not to exceed 3 minutes** on the topic of "How do you live life to the fullest?" (Bonus points if you can make the scholarship review committee laugh!)

Teacher endorsement included in video submission or signature on the application document

Applicants must submit a typed document including name, GPA, and statement of financial need on plain paper in 12-point font and double-spaced. Please submit by emailing the document and video to dolomemorial@gmail.com with "Duchesne Scholarship Application" as the subject line. Applications are due by March 9, 2026. Payment will be made directly to Duchesne High School in the winner's name. The scholarship recipient will be selected by the Boschert family. Please email dolomemorial@gmail.com with any questions.

Mel Plackemeier DAB Memorial Scholarship — 2026-2027 Seniors who have attended Duchesne for their first 3 years of high school

\$1,000 scholarships in honor of alumni parent Mel Plackemeier and funded by donations in Mel's memory, our Duchesne Athletic Boosters, and the Plackemeier family, awarded annually to 2 soon-to-be seniors who have attended DHS for FR/SO/JR years according to the following selection criteria.

-Cumulative GPA of at least 2.5

-List of activities and involvement at Duchesne, including athletics, arts, and service

-Essay of 300-500 words on the topic of "How my participation in co-curriculars has enhanced my years at Duchesne"

-Teacher's review of and endorsement signature on the essay

The student's name, GPA, activities/involvement details and the essay must be typed in 12pt font and double-spaced. The application should be well-written; typos and grammatical errors will not be accepted. Financial Need-Based Scholarships *(Duchesne Application with essays and BBFA required)*

For 2026-2027 Freshmen —

Jan Schultehenrich Memorial Scholarship

\$1,000 award to student with financial need who demonstrates good work habits and school citizenship.

Mary Lou Hannegan Scholarship

\$1,000 award, financial need required.

For 2026-2027 Sophomores only —

Class of 1964 Scholarship

\$1,964 award based on financial need.

For 2026-2027 Seniors only —

Dr. Henry & Roseann Clever Scholarship

\$1,000 award, GPA of 3.0 better and financial need required *For 2026-2027 All Grade Levels —*

Scheidegger Challenge Fund for Tuition Aid

\$1,000 award based on financial need.

St. Peter Parish Scholarship

\$500-\$1,500 according to market conditions, awarded to a St. Peter parish member who demonstrates financial need. Applicants must write a 300-500 word essay answering the following questions (in addition to the essay questions on the Duchesne Application).

-Tell how your Catholic education has prepared you to be a disciple of Christ.

-Tell how attending weekly Mass with your family helps you in your life with Christ.

Victoria Reid Scholarship

\$1,000 awarded to a student who demonstrates financial need and is of Hispanic heritage (50% or more—at least one parent must have origins in a Spanish-speaking country).

Merit- and Interest-Based Scholarships *(Duchesne Application with essays required)*

For 2026-2027 Freshmen —

Alumni Association Scholarship

\$1,000 award to the child or grandchild of a St. Peter/ Duchesne High School alum and selects Duchesne as their first-choice school. Renewable for subsequent years by maintaining good conduct and a minimum cumulative 3.0 grade point average.

Anita Venvertloh Memorial Art Scholarship

\$500 award to a student interested in art education at Duchesne. Along with this application, students must submit 3 to 5 samples of their best artwork; samples demonstrating proficiency in various media are preferred. (Samples will be returned.)

Charles & Carol Ryan Memorial Art Scholarship

\$1,000 award to a student from St. Charles Borromeo School who is interested in art classes or performing arts at Duchesne. In addition to the standard Duchesne scholarships application, applicants for this scholarship must write a paragraph on "How involvement in art or performing arts contributes to an individual's development as a whole."

Merit- and Interest-Based Scholarships, cont. (*Duchesne Application with essays required*)

For 2026-2027 Freshmen, cont. —

Dan Rupp Memorial Scholarship

\$3,000 award in memory of DHS alumni parent and hockey coach Dan Rupp. In addition to the standard Duchesne scholarships application, applicants for this scholarship must write a 300-500 word essay describing why Catholic education is important to them and include their plans for involvement in service, performing arts, and/or athletics while attending Duchesne.

Frank Kister Family Foundation Scholarship

\$1,000 award to a student who exemplifies the spirit of Frank Kister with regard to community service and awareness of the needs and interests of others. Automatically renewable if the student is in good standing.

Timothy O. Hill Memorial Scholarship

\$1,000 award based on school achievements, co-curricular activities, and service to the community.

For 2026-2027 Freshmen and Transfer Students —

Duchesne Band Scholarship

\$500 award to students who participate in the Duchesne Band for both semesters during that school year.

Duchesne Hockey Scholarship

Amount varies depending on circumstances and financial need, awarded to a DHS student member of the Duchesne Hockey Club.

For 2026-2027 Seniors only —

Ron Kjar Service & Scholarship Award

\$1,000 is awarded to several seniors with a 3.5 or better cumulative GPA who demonstrate a balance of community service and academic excellence. The application must be accompanied by two recommendations from faculty members attesting to those two attributes.

For 2026-2027 All Grade Levels —

Evan Kielty Memorial Scholarship

\$2,500 award. In addition to completing the Duchesne Application, students must submit a 3-5 minute video including examples of how/when the student emulates/has emulated the characteristics for which Evan is remembered: heart, grit, loyalty, and living outside of the box. Please include your plans for your time at Duchesne, activities you are/plan to be involved in, and what type of opportunity Duchesne High School will provide/has provided you.
