Baccalaureate and Graduation Information

Tuesday, May 14

Baccalaureate Mass and Awards – 6:30 p.m. at St. Charles Borromeo Church.

A Mass and Award Ceremony will be held at St. Charles Borromeo Church located at 601 N. 4th Street in St. Charles.

Dress code is formal.

We strongly encourage all our seniors to attend and celebrate their final Eucharist together.

It will be followed by a Senior Awards Celebration. There is no guest limit.

Wednesday, May 15

Graduation Practice – 9:45 a.m. in Performing Arts Center

Practice will begin **promptly** at 9:45 a.m. in the Performing Arts Center. Students need not be in uniform, but must be dressed appropriately for DHS as classes will be in session. Practice will not begin until all are present - so do not be late.

We recommend the young women wear or bring the shoes they will wear at graduation to practice walking in them up the steps.

Seniors will receive their graduation tickets and caps and gowns at this time.

Students will fill out the transcript request form indicating where their final transcripts should be sent. Please bring the information with you.

Attendance is required at practice in order for participation in the graduation ceremony. All outstanding tuition balances, fines, and grades must be resolved in order for students to participate in graduation. Caps and gowns will not be distributed to students who have outstanding accounts and diplomas will be held until such accounts are satisfied.

Thursday, May 16

Graduation – 7:30 p.m. in Duchesne multi-purpose auditorium.

Seating for guests with tickets will begin at 6:30 p.m. on a first come, first served basis. All graduates are to assemble in the Performing Arts Center no later than 7:00 p.m.

The young men should be clean shaven with dress shoes, dress slacks and shirt and tie. The young women should wear modest dress clothing, (preferably of a lighter color so as not to be seen through the gown), and dress shoes.

At the conclusion of graduation, each Senior is to return to the Performing Arts Center to return his/her gown (caps and tassels may be kept by the students). Once the gown is returned, the graduate will receive a packet which will contain


the actual diploma and other important materials. Grade reports will be emailed after the underclassmen have completed exams and grades are finalized.
